We help young people who are disengaged with physical activity – combining the power of creativity and youth co-created, real world projects – to provide society's young citizens with 360° opportunities to be, and stay active.

We support all 11-25 year olds across the UK, but focus on the least active young people, especially those in lower socio-economic groups.

League Leaders is a non profit sport, education and citizenship organisation. (in process of our charity application)

DELIVERY AREAS

#1 Fundamentals

Creative training and education experiences, built around young people's own barriers to entry for being active. Developing their sport, life and employability skills such as:

Teamwork / Resilience / Body confidence / Communication

#2 Live

Co-creation with young people directly – reviewing, designing and launching real world projects – innovating and influencing how organisations and sectors can help young people to be, and stay, active.

#3 Futures

Creating future employment opportunities for young people within sport sector and associated sector organisations, connecting them to their future workforce.

They ensure youth voice and ideas are heard within the sport sector and beyond, as well as being actively involved in the running of League Leaders, working with our Trustees, Advisors, Operations Team.

As a member of Coaches Corner you will gain wide-ranging skills through project involvement, creative training experiences and industry networking opportunities.

You will be directly responsible in changing the health and happiness of young people across the UK.

 / Attending and speaking at online / in-person talks and events.
- Speaking with other Coaches Corners members, advising our Trustees, Advisors, Operations Team.
- · Speaking with press and industry decision makers.

- You enjoy taking responsibility and being creative.

- You can be located in any part of the UK, but comfortable with the opportunity to travel across the UK to participate in projects and events when they happen, travel expenses will be paid for.
- There are no minimum educational or work experience requirements.

We understand that you may be in full time education or have work commitments and we are happy to be flexible around this, to give you the best possible experience and support your needs.
